



### *To-Do list for the wedding day.....*

1. Know your way around the property to ensure convenience on your wedding day.
2. Pick your music ahead of time and bring a couple of copies to destination with you. Make sure you check with your wedding coordinator to see what type of recording they use (CD/tape) and what equipment they offer (stereo/boom box).
3. Decide if you will be having your photos taken before or after your ceremony. If you are getting married later in the day make sure there will be enough daylight left for photos. Scout out locations early in the week at the same time as you plan to shoot on your wedding day. This way you can check the lighting and look for any obstacles or distractions in the background. If you are shooting separate from your ceremony location, time how long it will take for you to get to your ideal picture spot!
4. Most hotels will have a photographer on-site for your wedding photos but it is a good idea to ask someone who has traveled with you to take some photos as well, this way you have plenty of options to choose from.
5. Always eat a good breakfast. Once the day starts with hair appointments, dressing, ceremony, photos, it could be awhile before your next meal.
6. If your wedding is in the afternoon and your dinner is not until later in the afternoon make sure all of your guests are aware of this and fill them in on some ideas of what they can do between the times.
