Additional Info:

- This product must be booked at least 72 hours in advance of your travel date
- Confirmation for this product will be received at time of booking, unless you are booking within 14 days of wedding date. In this case, confirmation will be received within 48 hours, subject to availability
- Marriage can be conducted in English, French and German
- Translation service is available for an additional fee of USD100 direct to the supplier

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How can I get a marriage license in Miami Beach?

A: A marriage license must be obtained prior to the wedding ceremony. Obtaining a marriage license in Miami Beach is very easy. The cost is \$93.50 cash or credit card. US citizens will need to bring a valid driver license or passport for identification, non-US citizens will need to bring a valid passport. There is no waiting period for non-Florida residents, Florida residents must wait 3 days. Divorce papers are not required however you must provide the exact date of the previous divorce.

Q: Where and when can I get a marriage license in Miami Beach?

A: Monday through Friday 9:00am to 3:30pm, except on American holidays

Q: Can non-US citizens get married in Miami Beach and is it valid outside the USA?

A: Any citizens of the world can easily and legally get married in Florida. All you need in addition to the American marriage certificate is a document called Apostille which can be arranged for you within 48 hours at an additional fee of USD200.00. Your marriage is valid in any country of the world with this additional document.

Q: What documents do I need?

A: A valid passports or driver license for American citizens, A valid passport for non-American citizens and exact date when previous marriage ended.
